The Bureau of Indian Education invites students in grades 9-12, teachers and administrators to participate in the kickoff of the "I Care If You Graduate!" live speaker series. The series will feature leaders from government, academia, science, the arts and athletics. The speakers want to share their experiences with students and deliver an important message, "I Care If You Graduate!"

The first speaker in the series is Mr. Spike Bighorn, Chief of Staff for the Bureau of Indian Education. Mr. Bighorn grew up in Montana, graduating from Brockton High School and attending Miles Community College on a basketball scholarship. For over 24 years, he has served Indian communities and students. During his career, Mr. Bighorn has held a variety of elected, school and government positions including Tribal Executive Board Member, Tribal Chairman, School Principal, Education Line Officer, and Superintendent for the Fort Peck Agency in Poplar, Montana.

Mr. Bighorn has an Associate of Arts Degree, a Bachelor of Science Degree in Communications Education, and earned a Masters Degree in Business Administration from Gonzaga University in Spokane, Washington.

He understands the challenges that students in Indian Country face. He is able to engage students and share insights on how they can overcome obstacles and achieve their goals.
